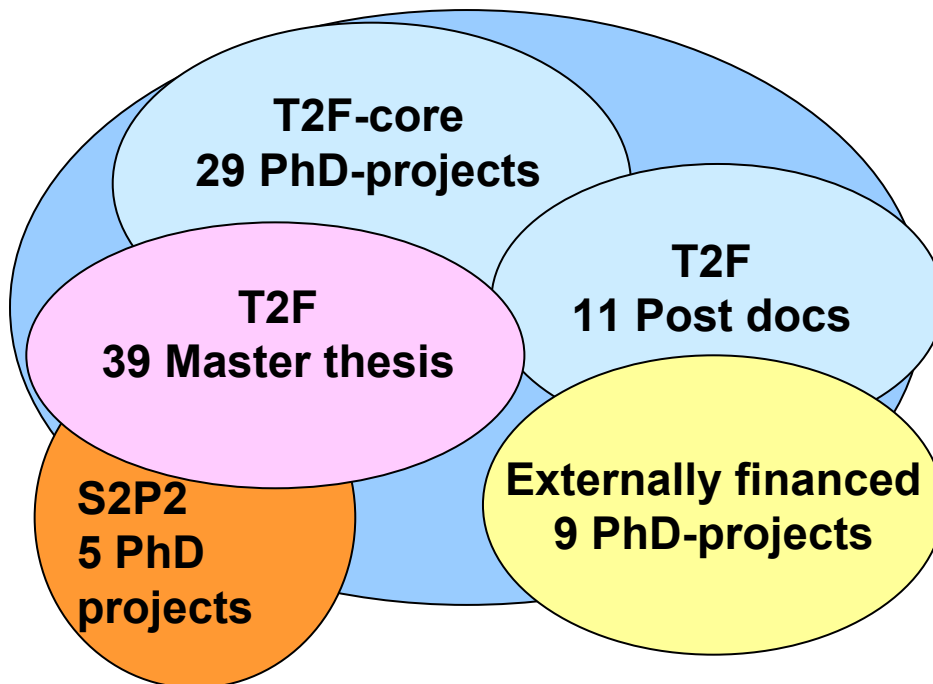


**The T2F-network is currently the largest research network in the world concerning printed information on paper**

## **PrintTech Research (T2F) is a domestic Swedish research program concerning printed information on paper**

### **Target**

The target for the program is to increase the competitiveness of the Swedish paper and graphic arts industry by building a higher knowledge level over the whole country through the distribution of research results within the program

### **Financing**

T2F has a basic financing of around 100 MSEK from the following organisations:

### **T2F greater than its basic financing**

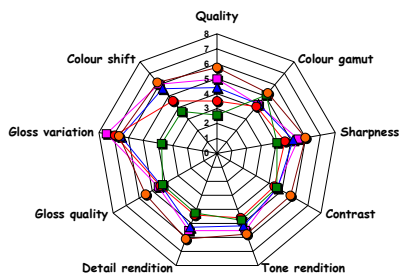
The total turnover of the program is with additional funding and associated projects close to 200 MSEK.



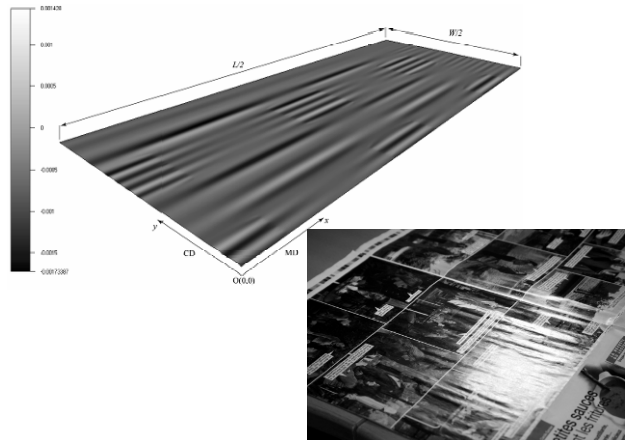
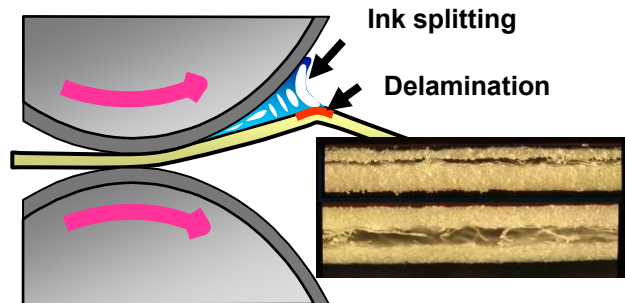
